

Chapter 6 – Jeopardy Notes

Where should you look when steering straight forward?

Focus on 4-6 seconds ahead but include the 12-15 and the 20-30 second zones in your visual search

What does over steer mean?

Turning the wheel too much

What does under steer mean?

Not turning the wheel enough

When backing straight back, tell me where your hands go and where you should look.

Left hand on wheel, right hand over back seat and look out the rear window

5. List the steps that you should follow when changing lanes

Look ahead and use mirrors

Cancel signal

Signal and check blind spot

Slow down

Accelerate gently as you change lanes

6. Where do your hands go on the wheel?

9-3 or 8-4

7. What are some steps that you should follow when making a moving turn?

Signal, Cover the brake, ½ way through, accelerate and let the wheel slide back into position

8. How far ahead of a turn should you get in the proper lane?

About a block

9. How far in advance should you signal before turning

200 feet or ½ a block

10. In a turn about, how many feet or blocks of visibility (minimum) should you allow?

500 feet or 1 block

11. How far away from the curb should you be before making a right turn?

3-4 feet

12. What does it mean if a road has a shared turn lane?

Cars traveling in both directions can use it when making turns

13. When should you begin your turn when turning right?

When you reach the curb line

14. When should you begin your turn when turning left?

When the front of your car is near the center of the intersection

15. Which way do you turn the wheel to back the car to the left?

Left

16. When turning, how does the turning radius of the front wheels compare with the back?

Back wheels have a shorter turning radius

17. What is the safest turn-about method?

Back into driveway on the right

What type of parking is shown in the picture below?

Angle parking

19. What type of parking is shown in the picture below?

Perpendicular parking

20. How many feet away from the truck should the car be before parking?

8 feet

21. What safety feature should you use when parking on a hill?

Parking brake

22. What type of parking would you use to park in the space below?

Parallel

23. List the reference points that you use when parallel parking.

Mirror to mirror, Mirror to middle of rear window, your car at a 45 degree angle with the car ahead of you

How would you park on the right side of the road, uphill, when there is a curb?

Steer left, shift to neutral, and roll back to the curb.

25. If you were in the blue car and about to parallel park, which way would you turn the wheel to begin parking?

All the way to the right

26. What main roads would I take to run over to Bluffton from here?

US 27 south to 124 and turn right or east on 124 to Bluffton
